DEPUTY PRINCIPAL UPDATE

As you would have heard recently in the media, schools will return to full classroom operations for all students as of next Monday, 25th May. It is expected that all students will return on this day.

To make this transition a success and to continue to follow the COVID guidelines within the school there are some protocols that we need to implement. We ask for support with these matters.

- All normal attendance procedures are back. As announced by the Minister, school attendance is now compulsory as of Monday 25th May. Any students with serious health concerns need to obtain a medical certificate and contact the Principal. No students will be allowed to sign out during the day unless there is a valid reason and a note is presented to the Deputy Principal before 9am. Do not ring up the school and ask for your child to be sent home. Seniors who have an approved flexible leave plan can leave during those approved times.
- Each classroom will be equipped with sanitizers, disinfectant wipes and tissues. Practical classrooms have individual PPE and cleaning protocols in place, including gloves and individual goggles.
- However, if your child has an illness, please keep them at home. Students who appear unwell will be sent home.
- No non-essential people to be on school premises. If you wish to see a staff members, an
 appointment must be made. It is recommended that communication with the school be done via
 phone or email. We thank parents for supporting us with this to date. This also includes parents
 delivering items to the school during the day this should not be occurring.
- Canteen will be open 5 days a week. It is still preferred that student's order their lunch before school for break 1, form available at the Front Office. From the canteen for break 2. Student's will not be allowed to leave school premises to get food, nor can it be delivered to the school. Students therefore either need to bring their own food or purchase from the canteen. Card is preferred over cash at the canteen. No more credit.
- School returns on Week A. All work needs to be returned from Monday at their first lesson for that subject. Any student who was issued with a school laptop, it needs to be returned before school on Monday to the Front Office with charger and fully charged as it will need to be used on Monday.
- Bubblers have been turned off. Students are asked to bring a water filled drink bottle.
- VET work placements for Year 12 will commence again as of 1st June.
- No excursions/incursions or assemblies until further notice. Year meetings rather than stage meetings will occur. We are able to do this because of our size.
- Protocols to sport and PE practicals will be modified to meet the AHPPC guidelines.
